## PET POLICY

## It is our policy No Pets/Animals are allowed in our cabins.

Tennessee law does not use the term 'Service Animals,' it refers only to "Dog Guides." Dog Guides are animals that lead or accompany someone who is blind, deaf, hard of hearing, or otherwise physically disabled.

Dog Guides are animals that have been trained professionally to work and aid their handlers.

Host must be notified prior to booking of all Dog Guides.

We expect our guest to honor our pet policy.

Some guest may have extreme allergies towards animals, whether it is fur, hair, or animal dander, and could require medical attention because of it.

If a guest violates our policy, it causes an additional expense for deep cleaning due to the medical risk that could be impaired on future guest.

This cleaning would have to be done to protect the medical safety of future guest. Unfortunately, the time frame to do all the cleaning that would be needed would interfere with the next guest being able to check-in at their scheduled time.

If this should occur, payment would be the responsibility of the violating guest for the additional cleaning cost.
